Addendum # 01 must be acknowledged or you will be deemed non-responsive

The costs of removal and replacement of rock or unsuitable materials shall not be a part of the Bid.

(ref: page 1B-1, paragraph 7, Subsurface Conditions)

7. Sub-Surface Conditions: A sub-surface investigation has not been made on any portion of the work, and the Owner and Engineer make no representation or express any opinion on such conditions. Excavation for the project is unclassified for rock. The contractor shall include in his bid all cost of excavation and removal and replacement of unsuitable materials. The contractor shall make his own analysis of the materials to be encountered, and include prices for removal and replacement of these materials in his unit prices for construction unless allowances for removal and replacement are provided in the Bid. It is expected that quantities may be significantly less or greater than shown in the Bid since Bid quantities are established without any knowledge of the underground conditions, and it would be unusual for the quantities to be close to those actually encountered. The prospective bidder must form his own opinion of the character of the sub-surface materials to be encountered in excavating for construction of the various facilities and completing the work, and include all costs and charges therefore in his bid.
