


AIKEN COUNTY RESIDENTIAL CONVENIENCE CENTERS

Barden Construction & Demolition (C&D)

HOURS: Monday through Saturday,
7:30 AM to 5 PM

Wagener Landfill

1769 Wagener Trail Road, Wagener
HOURS: Wednesday ONLY,
7:30 AM to 5 PM

Materials accepted at the landfills include yard debris, roofing material, common C&D debris (except Creosote-treated material), concrete, decking, plumbing, furniture, etc.

OPEN BURNING of household garbage is PROHIBITED!



NOTICE TO HAULERS

All commercial or business haulers using the landfill to dispose of waste generated in Aiken County **must have a landfill hauler's permit** before delivering loads.

Permits are issued by the Aiken County Public Works Department at their main office. Each permit is \$25 and renewable every two years. A copy of your driver's license, the vehicle's registration and a completed hauler application (signed by the owner or authorized representative) is required to obtain a permit.

ITEMS	DESCRIPTION	HOW TO RECYCLE	WHERE ITEMS ARE ACCEPTED	
			CONVENIENCE CENTERS	LANDFILLS
ALUMINUM CANS	Beverage cans (e.g., soda, energy, iced tea)	Rinse thoroughly. DO NOT CRUSH.	YES	NO
ANTIFREEZE	Antifreeze from automobiles and small trucks	See the center attendant for instructions. DO NOT put in the used motor oil collection tanks.	YES	NO
APPLIANCES	Refrigerators, washers, dryers, etc.	See the center attendant for instructions. Large appliances should be taken to the landfill.	YES	YES
BATTERIES, LEAD-ACID (RECHARGEABLE)	Batteries from automobiles, boats, lawn mowers, etc.	If leaking, place the battery in a secure container. ALKALINE BATTERIES (single-use) ARE NOT ACCEPTED. Place them in your household garbage.	YES	NO
BOOKS	Hardback or soft cover books	Place books in the recycling compactor.	YES	NO
CARDBOARD	Corrugated, cardboard boxes with NO WAX FINISH) and brown paper bags	Flatten. Keep items clean and dry. Cardboard should have NO CONTAMINATES (e.g., paint, solvents, oil, grease). PIZZA BOXES and PAPERBOARD (e.g., cereal and shoe boxes) ARE NOT accepted.	YES	NO
CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION (C&D) DEBRIS	Furniture, C&D debris and decking	These items are accepted from residences ONLY – NO BUSINESSES.	YES	YES
ELECTRONICS, HOUSEHOLD	Computers, laptops, televisions, monitors and printers	Remove cords and cables.	AT DESIGNATED CENTERS ONLY	NO
FLUORESCENT & COMPACT FLUORESCENT LIGHT (CFL) BULBS		Wrap bulbs or place them in their original packaging.	YES	NO
HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE		All garbage MUST BE BAGGED.	YES	NO
MAGAZINES, MIXED PAPER & UNWANTED MAIL	Magazines, inserts, paperback/telephone books and “junk” mail	Keep items loose, clean and dry. DO NOT TIE OR BAG. Remove plastic cards or wrap.	YES	NO
MATTRESSES & BOX SPRINGS			YES	YES
MOTOR OIL	Used motor oil, kerosene, power steering fluid, automatic transmission and hydraulic fluids	LIMIT 5 GALLONS PER VISIT. BRAKE FLUID IS NOT accepted. Motor oil must be free of water and debris.	YES	NO
MOTOR OIL BOTTLES		Remove caps and drain completely.	YES	NO
MOTOR OIL FILTERS	Used motor oil from cars and small trucks	Puncture oil filters and drain completely.	YES	NO
NEWSPAPER	Newspapers and glossy Inserts	DO NOT TIE OR BAG.	YES	NO
OIL/GASOLINE MIXES	Oil, gasoline and diesel fuel mixes	LIMIT 5 GALLONS PER VISIT. BRAKE FLUID IS NOT accepted.	YES	NO
PLASTIC BAGS	Plastic grocery and shopping bags	Look for a recycling container at local grocery store or other retailer.	NO	NO
PLASTIC BOTTLES, JUGS & CONTAINERS	Food, beverage, bleach, laundry, shampoo and other containers usually marked with a recycling symbol on the bottom	Discard lids and caps. Rinse thoroughly. TUBS, TRAYS, BAGS, FILM and STYROFOAM ARE NOT accepted.	YES	NO
PROPANE TANKS		Tanks must be empty and have the valves removed.	YES	NO
SCRAP METAL	Metal appliances, lawn furniture and ferrous equipment, food cans, etc.	Remove glass and plastic shelves from appliances. Drain oil/gas mixtures from machinery. Rinse all food cans thoroughly.	YES	YES
TIRES	Car, motorcycle, van and small truck tires from residents	Remove rims. LIMIT 4 TIRES PER VISIT. Please call (803) 642-1533 for large tires. Tires ARE NOT ACCEPTED from businesses at drop-off centers. For recycling options, businesses should call (803) 642-1533.	YES	YES
YARD TRIMMINGS	Tree limbs and leaves	Yard trimming are accepted from residents ONLY. At convenience centers, limbs are restricted to 3 inches in diameter and less than 6 feet in length. CREOSOTE-TREATED MATERIAL IS NOT accepted. Large loads MUST be taken to a landfill.	YES	YES
