Project:

The Whiskey Road Feasibility Study was initiated in March 2022 and is anticipated to conclude by the summer of 2023. The study will help create a safety plan for the four and a half (4.5) mile stretch of Whiskey Road (SC 19) beginning at the intersection of Powderhouse Road (S-440) and ending at Eagle Road (C-2867).

Aiken County and the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT), are seeking public input regarding the findings contained in the Feasibility Study. High priority projects will address driver, cyclist, and pedestrian safety as well as traffic congestion.

Meeting:

A public information meeting is scheduled for February 28, 2023 to discuss findings from the study, as well as gather feedback from the public on potential project recommendations. The meeting will be a drop-in format, and will include displays and handouts for viewing as well as the opportunity to discuss specifics of the Feasibility Study with the project team.
