

## **PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE**

### **SC 19 (Whiskey Rd) at L2492 (Eagle Rd) and S-447 (Old Whiskey Rd.)**

This proposed project consists of installing a new traffic signal at the SC 19 (Whiskey Road) and L-2492 (Eagle Road) intersection, a new designated left turn lane from SC 19 onto Eagle Road, newly designated right and left turn lanes from Eagle Road onto SC 19 and a cul-de-sac along S-447 (Old Whiskey Road).

#### **Meeting:**

Tuesday, July 23, 2019, from 5 – 7 PM at Zion Fair Baptist Church in their fellowship hall located at 97 Dry Branch Rd., Aiken, SC 29803. The meeting will have a drop-in type format with displays for viewing and citizens will have the opportunity to provide written comments. Formal, verbal comments will not be taken during this meeting. Project information, including meeting material, will also be available here after the meeting and uploaded to the SCDOT website the day of the meeting.

#### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity to review and discuss individually with representatives from the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) the proposed intersection improvements at SC 19 (Whiskey Rd.), L-2492 (Eagle Rd.) and S-447 (Old Whiskey Rd.) outside the town of New Ellenton. The proposed project will include signaling the SC 19 and Eagle Rd. intersection, a new designated left turn lane from SC 19 onto Eagle Rd., newly designated right and left turn lanes from Eagle Rd. onto SC 19 and a cul-de-sac along Old Whiskey Rd. Another purpose of this meeting is to gather information from the public or any interested organization on historic or cultural resources in the area. Personnel from SCDOT will be available to answer questions and discuss the project with interested citizens on an individual basis.
