The South Carolina Rabies Control Act requires that all dogs, cats and ferrets have a current rabies vaccination. For the majority of vaccines, the minimum age to vaccinate these pets is three (3) months of age. Upon vaccination, the veterinarian will provide a serially numbered rabies tag the pet should wear around its neck. The licensed veterinarian will also provide a certificate of vaccination.
